CRISIS TRAINING FOR FIRST RESPONDERS



Scott, Mary and Reverend Norris

Reverend Richard Norris spoke to us regarding the need for crisis intervention for first responders: those with fire services, Law enforcement, EMS, hospital staff and others involved in responding to emergency situations in our county. Reverend Norris would like to bring crisis intervention trainers here to train individuals who would be providing the crisis counseling for the first responders.

Crisis intervention can be described as a short term intense therapy that emphasizes identification of the event that triggered the emotional trauma. Focus is on neutralizing the trauma and mobilizing coping skills.

First responders or Protective Service Workers who respond to manmade and natural disasters experience daily career exposure to acute stress and trauma. By working in professional positions in law enforcement, fire sciences, emergency medical services, search and rescue, 911 operators and dispatchers, emergency room staff (including doctors and nurses), child welfare workers, and even psychotherapists, these individuals experience direct or secondary trauma from the work environment.

The work of caring for the emotional and physical needs of others takes its toll on those in the trenches. In these inimitable circumstances, the exposure can lead to direct traumas and/or vicarious trauma for the professional in a first responder role. Training will focus on clinical skills for providing emergency mental health services to first responders while adhering to the EMDR protocol in the treatment of those professionals who are exposed to trauma in the line of duty. Those trained will learn how to develop a treatment plan with methods for treating professional traumas specific to first responders.
